We discover our error later and attempted to file a form 8868 extension on 7/7/2009 electronically using efile.form990.org. We also mailed in a paper copy of form 8868 on the same day. We had been trying since mid-May to file our return on Urban Institute's efile.form990.org, but their software was undergoing a complete change for the new form 990 and was not ready until today, and I am using a beta version at that. So the combination of human error and the lack of availability of our online filing software has made this filing late. All of our previous records were kept by the Urban Institute, so we did not want to change and file with some other group.

<p>NATURAL AREA CONSERVATION. Friends of Old Annville supports and maintains the Quittie Creek Nature Park for the recreational use and benefit of residents of Annville, PA. Park is the site of historic lime kilns and the site of the foundation of a water mill for grinding lime. Historical aspects of the park are emphasized.</p>	\$0		\$0
<p>PUBLIC PARK RECREATION. Friends of Old Annville, Inc. oversaw the construction of a wooden footbridge across the Quittapahilla Creek in the Quittie Creek Nature Park to provide a pedestrian link between the communities of Annville Township and South Annville Township. The bridge provides walking access for South Annville residents to the Quittie Creek Nature Park and to the Annville National Historic District. The construction project, initiated in 2007, was funded in large part by the Pennsylvania Department of Transportation (PENNDOT provided \$63513.64 in 2008 and \$73,320 in 2007) and by a \$55,500 grant in 2007 from the Pennsylvania Department of Community and Economic Development (DCED). Project expenses in 2008 were \$68,429.87. The footbridge was begun in 2007 and completed in 2008. Ownership of the bridge was transferred to Annville Twonship in 2008.
