<p>PUBLIC PARK RECREATION. Friends of Old Annaville, Inc. oversaw the construction of a wooden footbridge across the Quittaphilla Creek in the Quittie Creek Nature Park to provide a pedestrian link between the communities of Annaville Township and South Annaville Township. The bridge provides walking access for South Annaville residents to the Quittie Creek Nature Park and to the Annaville National Historic District. The construction project, initiated in 2007, was funded in large part by the Pennsylvania Department of Transportation (PENNDOT provided \$63513.64 in 2008 and \$73,320 in 2007) and by a \$55,500 grant in 2007 from the Pennsylvania Department of Community and Economic Development (DCED). Project expenses in 2008 were \$68,429.87. The footbridge was begun in 2007 and completed in 2008. Ownership of the bridge was transferred to Annaville Twonship in 2008. Annaville Township will continue to own, insure, and maintain the bridge for use by local residents. Final aspects of bridge construction were completed in 2009 for which project expenses were \$5570. Project served 7600 residents in Annaville and south Annaville Townships.</p>	\$5,570		\$5,570

<p>HISTORIC PRESERVATION. In 1998, Friends of Old Annaville restored the Annaville Train Station on leased private land within Annaville Township. The approximate value of the building in 2008 was \$130,000. The station serves as a site for programs and meetings of Friends of Old Annaville and as an archive of historical information about Annaville, PA.
